

FAQ on Prime Student File

Q-1: What are the required documents for opening Student File?

Ans:

- Offer letter issued by the educational institution in support of admission
- Estimate/ invoice relating to annual tuition fees, living expenses etc issued by the educational institution
- Educational certificates
- Declaration by the student
- Valid passport

Q-2: Who can be the financier/sponsor of the student File?

Ans:

Anyone can be the financier. However 1st degree relationship is preferable. But if there is any Specific obligation by the educational institution regarding the eligible financier/sponsor, is to be fulfilled.

Q-3: What are the required documents for Sponsor/Financier of student file?

Ans:

- If financier/sponsor already has any kind of Current or Savings Account with Prime Bank, a copy of NID & Passport size photo are enough for student file opening.
- If financier/sponsor is NTB, all kind of account opening documents including KYC & FATCA Form will be required.

Q-4: What is the permissible remittance at a time?

Ans:

The facility of purchasing foreign exchange/remittance will not be admissible for more than one academic year at a time.

Q-5: Is there any additional Fees and Charges of Student File?

Ans:

In case of choosing courses out of the eligible course list, BDT 3,000 will be required as processing fee for obtaining Bangladesh Bank approval/permission for the 1st time and BDT 1,500 for each sub-sequent approval of transaction.

Q-6: Where Student File can be opened?

Ans:

Student File service is available at 28 AD Branches of Prime Bank.
